Welcome to the 2019 Spring Campaign edition of our newsletter and a big welcome to Spring following a very cold winter! The Spring Campaign is our opportunity to share what has been happening in the Foundation and to let our supporters know how their donations have made a difference - right here in Brandon!

For this year's Spring Campaign, the equipment list at the BRHC has again been thoughtfully reviewed to select items for potential purchase. We are hoping to raise the funds to purchase the following items:

Option #1: Fetal monitor wireless base - Maternity - Value \$12,677. This monitor will allow patients to move freely, increase patient satisfaction, encourage position changes, and is waterproof to allow tub use.

Option #2: Power tool for trauma set - Operating Room - Value \$22,731. Used for emergency orthopedic cases, this additional equipment will ensure patients do not have to wait for surgery if the other tool is being cleaned/sterilized.

Option #3: Transcutaneous bilirubin meter - Maternity - Value \$9,410. Device to measure bilirubin levels and decrease the number of blood draws for newborns.



PATIENT WARD RENOVATIONS NEAR COMPLETION



PATIENT WARD RENOVATION CAMPAIGN
Raising funds to help create, renovate
& rejuvenate inpatient care areas

On September 29, 2014, the Foundation announced the launch of our "Room for Renewal" Campaign, to raise \$600,000 to help meet the required community contribution to create, renovate and rejuvenate the inpatient care areas of the Brandon Regional Health Centre. In just 10 months on July 24, 2015, the Foundation announced the \$600,000 goal had been achieved!

We are pleased to share that the renovations are expected to be complete by the end of May, 2019. A big Foundation thank you is extended to everyone who supported our Campaign!

2nd Floor: Westman Dreams for Kids Pediatrics Unit

Previously on the 5th floor, now on the 2nd floor, the unit includes 7 single patient rooms, with the ability to increase to 8 if required. As well there is a new playroom (with a big window allowing for natural light), a staff area, and designated storage space for equipment.





4th Floor and 5th Floors (Acute Medicine):

Both the 4th and 5th floors have been renovated and the total capacity increased by 12 for a new total of 60 beds. The renovated

space now hosts single, double, and triple bed rooms. Improvements also include conference space, assessment rooms, and clean and soiled receiving areas.

Overall, the renovations provide for a more comfortable patient stay as patient rooms and bathroom sizes have increased.

General upgrading of infrastructure (plumbing, heating, electrical, HVAC, etc.) was completed in all phases of the renovation.
