The Pumps for Life Campaign is targeted to raise \$900,000 to cover the cost of replacing the entire fleet of infusion pumps at BRHC. In October of 2020 the Pumps for Life Campaign received its first donations. Following the official launch of our campaign in February 2021, the results have been remarkable. At the time of writing we have raised over \$899,000 of our \$900,000 goal Thanks to you, our donors ,we are in the home stretch.

We have received amazing support from a number of organizations, businesses, neighboring municipalities, along with the generosity of a number of bequests to the BRHC Foundation.

Infusion pumps are used to administer intravenous medications, blood transfusions, fluid replacement, and chemotherapy drugs. These pumps are used in every department of the hospital, which means your support for this campaign could have an impact on anyone receiving care.
