## CAPITAL CAMPAIGN GOAL INCREASES TO \$4 MILLION!

June 2024 marked the official launch of our capital campaign, A Foundation for Care, with the goal of raising \$2 million to support the

construction of the BRHC's new Critical Care building, along with needed equipment. The project will feature a new 16-bed Intensive Care Unit on the main level., approximately 30 additional medical beds, an outdoor courtyard, mechanical space, and shell space for potential future expansions.

In June 2025, just one year after the launch of the campaign, the BRHC Foundation has increased their fundraising goal to \$4 million to further support the project. As of September 2025, we are over 30% of the way!

# ELTON COLLEGIATE YOUTH IN PHILATHROPY PROVIDES TURTLE TUB FOR NICU

The BRHC Foundation was the recipient of the Elton Collegiate 2024 Youth in Philanthropy grant that was generously given through the Brandon and Area Foundation (BACF). This grant was designated towards the purchase of a Turtle Tub - Cart for the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at the Brandon Regional Health Centre. The Turtle Tub allows for swaddle bathing of newborns which keeps the



newborn warm and calm during the bathing process. The mobile bathing station provides ease of use, infant safety, comfort, and infection control while keeping the newborn warm and comfortable. The Turtle Tub also allows for the parent to partake during the bathing process transforming bathing into a positive experience.
